In response to the economic hardship experienced by small businesses resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, the County of Rockland is launching the Small Business Relief Grant Program. The goal is to keep businesses open and retain jobs. It is a grant program in response to businesses that are at-risk of closing or laying off employees due to social distancing policies and other orders and policies related to COVID-19.

Funding Source: County of Rockland's HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) Program in the amount of \$600,000.

Funding Amounts: A maximum of \$45,000 per business, based upon need. Minimum request is \$5,000.

Application Request: Applications will be accepted until grant money is exhausted.
